On **14 May 2026**, the Municipality of Cavallino-Treporti was awarded the Blue Flag for the 20th consecutive year, an achievement that only a few destinations in Italy can claim.

During the summer, the **Tourist Environmental Centre (C.A.T.)** will be opened, managed by Parco Turistico di Cavallino Treporti, on behalf of the municipality, with the possibility for guests and residents to go on **excursions in the pine forest with an environmental guide every Tuesday and Friday** from 9.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and from 3.30 p.m. to 7 p.m.

WHAT IS THE BLUE FLAG?

The Blue Flag is a recognition **conferred by the FEE** (Foundation for Environmental Education) **to coastal locations that meet quality criteria relating to parameters of bathing water and the service offered**, also taking into account the cleanliness of beaches and tourist landing places.

Established in 1987, the European year for the environment, the campaign is carried out in all the states **by the FEE, which, through a national Jury Committee, carry out visits** to check out the candidate cities and then submit applications to the International FEE.

The award is given each year to beaches in 49 countries around the world, according to criteria chosen and by the FEE.

To award this prize, tourist resorts are subjected to a thorough analysis from year to year and **must meet certain quality criteria**. The areas of evaluation are:

- **environmental management**
- **water quality**
- **environmental education**
- **services offered and safety**

This year, as every year since 2006, the Blue Flag rewards the Cavallino Treporti coastline confirming the excellence of a unique territory of great naturalistic and environmental value. A territory that, thanks to the work of all its tourist operators, aims to raise the quality standards already achieved to guarantee increasingly sustainable tourism.

The campaign is supported each year by a series of **educational activities to raise awareness of environmental protection** aimed at tourists, inhabitants and tour operators.

SUMMER AGENDA 2026

From 25 July to 9 August, the “Blue Flag Promotion Week” will take place in collaboration with local accommodation providers.

On 25 July, World Drowning Prevention Day, the event “**Safe at the Seaside**” will be held on the beach in front of Camping Mediterraneo, in collaboration with Turismo Srl Wela.

On 31 July, the “Summer Festival” will take place in Piazza Santa Maria Elisabetta, with a focus on health and safety. The event is organised by Amici del Paviner, Pro Loco and ULSS 4. During the evening, the awarding of the 2026 Blue Flag will be officially celebrated in the presence of residents and visitors.
